SUOMUSSALMI AND HOSSA

- A JOURNEY INTO THE HEART OF NORTHERN WILDERNESS

Nestled in the northern part of Arctic Lakeland (Kainuu), just over an hour's drive from Kajaani, Suomussalmi is a place where nature and history meet. This serene region invites you to experience all four seasons, with its rolling, forest-covered eskers and ancient woodlands that beckon explorers along scenic, tranquil trails.

Suomussalmi is rich in history and natural beauty. Key highlights include Raate Road, the site of fierce battles during the Winter War, the striking Silent People landscape art installation, and the stunning Hossa National Park. The region offers a chance to experience the unique art and sounds of the Silent People, the mystical echoes of the Musical Forest, and the profound historical significance of Raate Road.

Imagine being immersed in the quiet, untamed wilderness of Hossa-Suomussalmi far removed from the bustle of daily life. Suomussalmi and Hossa provide the perfect escape — a place to relax, rejuvenate, and indulge in unforgettable outdoor adventures. During winter, the Northern Lights cast a magical glow across the sky, enhancing the already enchanting landscape.

Hossa National Park offers a network of wellmaintained, easily accessible trails that wind through towering forests, along sandy eskers, and beside clear, glistening lakes. The park is a haven for hikers and nature lovers yet remains blissfully free from the crowds of mass tourism. Here, you can lose yourself in a world where time seems to slow — only nature, silence, and the starry sky above. Notable sites in Hossa include the ancient Värikallio rock paintings and Julma-Ölkky, Finland's largest canyon lake, both of which are truly one-of-a-kind.

Step into a magical realm where art and nature create a unique symphony at *Soiva Metsä*, Suomussalmi's enchanting Musical Forest. This extraordinary outdoor gallery showcases remarkable musical instruments that double as stunning works of art, thoughtfully scattered throughout the pristine Finnish landscape. Each piece, masterfully crafted by renowned instrument builders Markku Penttilä, Olli Penttilä, and Pekka Westerholm, invites visitors to become part of the forest's melody.

Located in the scenic Kaunisniemi area, just 7 kilometers from Suomussalmi center, this interactive art installation is accessible to all who wish to experience its wonder. Adventure seekers can reach the Musical Forest by following the picturesque Seitenahveninen hiking trail from the Suomussalmi center's Pitämä residential area. The trail winds through beautiful wilderness, past recreational fishing grounds, and leads eventually to this unique destination. For those preferring a shorter journey, follow the marked path from the Seitenahveninen parking area, past the summer theatre, to discover this harmonious blend of nature and artistic expression.

Come play, explore, and immerse yourself in this one-of-a-kind forest where every visit creates a new symphony!

Instructions: The Soiva Metsä instruments can also be reached by foot along the Seitenahveninen hiking trail, starting from the Suomussalmi center's Pitämä residential area and leading to the Seitenahveninen Recreational Fishing and Trekking area. From the Seitenahveninen parking area, follow the road to the "Kesäteatteri" (summer theatre), then take the path that leads to Soiva Metsä.



THE RAATE ROAD

The battles of the Winter War in Suomussalmi, especially along the Raate Road, attract tens of thousands of visitors every year. The Winter War Museum at Raatteen Portti is an excellent place to learn about these historic battles. You can explore the Raate Road either on your own with the help of brochures or by taking a guided tour with an expert guide.

THE RAATE FRONTIER **GUARD MUSEUM**

The Frontier Guard Museum, located at the eastern end of Raate Road in Suomussalmi, has been restored to its 1939 state. It provides insight into life at a frontier guard post before the Second World War. The museum also offers information about the events of the Winter War along Raate Road and their impact on life at the frontier guard.

WINTER WAR MUSEUM RAATTEEN PORTTI

The Winter War exhibition at Raatteen Portti explores various aspects of Suomussalmi before and during the Winter War. It covers topics such as evacuation preparations, the effect of the harsh winter on the war's outcome, the fate of the Red Army, the valuable spoils of war Finland gained along Raate Road, and the post-war conditions that people returned to.

WINTER WAR MONUMENT

The Winter War Monument is the newest memorial along the Raate Road. It consists of a stone field and a central memorial. The stone field, covering an area of about 3 hectares, contains approximately 17,000 stones commemorating the victims and suffering of the war.

The central memorial, titled "Wide Embrace," features four wooden arches, topped by 105 brass bells that ring in the wind — one for each day of the Winter War. The monument was designed by Erkki Pullinen, a native of Suomussalmi.


Location: In the municipality of Suomussalmi, in the Arctic Lakeland region of Finland.

Hossa is renowned for its magnificent and unique wilderness. Visitors can immerse themselves in the serenity of nature and enjoy a variety of outdoor activities. The park's magnificent wilderness is an excellent destination, with trails running through pine forests that invite hiking and cycling, and crystal-clear lakes ideal for canoeing and fishing. The national park offers marked routes for paddling and fishing, with varying conditions to suit different preferences. Hossa is also famous for the Hossa Värikallio Rock Paintings and Finland's largest canyon lake, Julma-Ölkky.

Accessibility: Hossa National Park and the surrounding areas offer accessible, versatile trails and facilities. Some of the campfire sites and dry toilets have been designed to accommodate wheelchair users. The national park also features jetties from which wheelchair users can fish and board a boat.


Although Hossa is famous for its summer activities, it is also a winter wonderland. In winter, visitors can enjoy activities such as:

Värikallion Kaarros Trail

Hossa National Park is home to the northernmost Stone Age rock paintings in Finland, with an estimated age of 3,500 to 4,500 years. The Värikallion Kaarros trail leads to Lake Somerjärvi, where a footbridge and viewing platform have been built. From here, you can view the rock paintings up close, just a few meters away. The trail is of medium to demanding difficulty and is marked in nature with yellow paint markers.

BEAR WATCHING & PHOTOGRAPHY

An evening snack and a dry eco-toilet are available in the hide.

The refurbished and rebuilt buildings, which have been in use since the late 19th century, have been relocated and repurposed for the company's use.
